2nd Ministerial Meeting between Members of the League of Arab States and the Pacific Small Island Developing States

The Second Ministerial Meeting between the Members of the League of Arab States and the Pacific Small Island Developing States was held in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia on the 11th and 12th of June 2023, highlighting pertinent issues in relation to addressing the adverse effect of climate change on sea level rise, ocean acidification, building resilience to water issues, food security, diversifying energy sources, safe island infrastructure and others.
